



Demand Surcharge for U.S. international services

Updated Aug. 18, 2026

Non-standard and oversized items require additional labor and equipment to sort, handle, and deliver safely. As FedEx prepares for high demand during the holiday season, we are implementing the following fees to offset the cost of these items during this time of the year.

International Non-standard shipment¹ Demand Surcharges

Surcharge name	Applicable services	Surcharge amount	Effective date
Demand — Additional Handling Surcharge ²	International Package Services ³	\$8.80 per package	Sept. 21, 2026–Feb. 7, 2027
Demand — Oversize Charge ²	International Package Services ³	\$95.75 per package	Sept. 21, 2026–Feb. 7, 2027
Demand — Unauthorized Charge ^{2,4}	International Package Services ³	\$200 per package	Sept. 21, 2026–Feb. 7, 2027

¹Any shipment meeting any of the criteria or conditions for the Additional Handling Surcharge, the Oversize Charge, the Ground Unauthorized Package Charge, or the Unauthorized Charge will be considered and referred to as a Non-standard shipment.

⁴Effective Sept. 21, 2026, the Demand — Ground Unauthorized Package Charge will be renamed the Demand — Unauthorized Charge.
